Democratic Vice President Survey June 6-8, 2020

Overview

This report contains the results of a Civiqs survey of 1105 registered Democrats and Democratic-leaning Independents in the United States from June 6-8, 2020. The survey was conducted online, among selected members of the Civiqs research panel. Sampled individuals were emailed by Civiqs and responded using a personalized link to the survey at civiqs.com.

Respondents were asked an initial screening question: "Do you think of yourself as a: Democrat, Independent, Republican, Other or none?" and are screened out if they responded "Republican".

The survey results are weighted by age, race, gender, education, and party identification to be representative of the population of Democrats and Democratic-leaning Independents in the United States. The general design effect due to weighting is 1.06. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 3.0\%$ at the 95% confidence level, accounting for the design effect. All survey results in this report are reported as percentages.
