From August 6 to 9, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,586 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±2 percentage points.

[1] The PRO Act is legislation to strengthen labor laws. This
proposal would give workers more power during disputes at
work, add penalties for companies that retaliate against
workers who try to form a union, give more workers
currently classified as contractors in the gig economy (like
Uber drivers) the right to organize and form unions, and
eliminate right-to-work laws which allow employees to enjoy
the benefits of a union contract without contributing to the
costs.

Do you support or oppose the PRO Act?

[2] As you may have read or heard, workers at an Amazon warehouse in Bessemer, Alabama tried to form a union in April 2021. The workers ultimately voted to **not** form a union.

A federal official is now saying that this election should be rerun because of Amazon's behavior during the campaign, including setting up a mailbox outside the facility to collect ballots and requiring employees attend meetings that risked giving workers the impression their stance on the union vote was being tracked by the company.
