

From October 15th to October 18, 2020, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 933 likely voters in Texas using web panel and SMS respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is +/- 3.2 percentage points
