

From October 27 to November 1, 2020, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 951 likely voters in Iowa using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3.2 percentage points.
