From July 30 to August 2, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,254 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

[1] The United States currently has a "Buy American" rule
that requires any products purchased by the federal
government with taxpayer dollars to have at least 55 percent
of the value of their component parts made in the United
States.

President Biden is proposing a new government rule to raise this requirement to 60 percent, with a gradual increase to 75 percent over the next nine years.

[2] President Biden has recently proposed a new rule to increase transparency and accountability in "Buy American" rules for purchases made by the government using taxpayer dollars.
