

# DATA FOR PROGRESS

From December 23 to 25, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,207 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

**[27]** The Federal Reserve System ("the Fed") promotes an effective US economy by setting monetary policy and monitoring financial institutions like banks.

For example, the Fed sets target interest rates and buys securities (like stocks and bonds) to raise or lower the unemployment rate, encourage or discourage spending, and affect the kinds of goods being produced.

The Fed also stress-tests private banks and monitors them for corruption to try to keep them working well.

On its website, the Fed explains its goals, decisions, and rules, and provides contact information to submit comments and concerns.
