## **M** DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From September 12 to 27, 2024, Data for Progress conducted 6,152 respondent interviews over five pooled surveys of U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. Each sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and 2020 recalled vote. The surveys were conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points, and crosstabs of subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance.
