

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From February 7 to 9, 2024, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,220 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 3 percentage points.

"Hostile sexism" scores were calculated using questions from the Ambivalent Sexism Inventory (ASI) from the University of California-San Diego. Voters were asked if they agree or disagree with the following statements:

- Women exaggerate problems they have at work
- Women are too easily offended
- When women lose to men in a fair competition, they typically complain about being discriminated against
- Women seek power by getting control over men

For each response, voters were assigned a point value: 0 for strongly disagree, 1 for somewhat disagree, 2 for don't know, 3 for somewhat agree, and 4 for strongly agree. Cumulative scores of 0 to 5 represent "low" hostile sexism, scores of 6 to 11 represent "medium" hostile sexism, and scores of 12 to 16 represent "high" hostile sexism.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
