

From July 29 to August 2, 2024, Data for Progress, in partnership with Split Ticket, conducted a survey of 1,447 likely voters pooled in Michigan, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters across the pooled states by age, gender, education, race, geography, and 2020 recalled vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. The design effect for this survey is 1.23. NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
