

From August 16 to 21, 2024, Data for Progress and Climate Power conducted a survey of 833 Latino likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. This sample is also weighted to account for an oversample of Latino likely voters in Arizona, Georgia, Nevada, and Pennsylvania, with an unweighted N of 306, to ensure proportional representation of likely voters. The sample was weighted to be representative by age, gender, education, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English and Spanish. The margin of error is ± 3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error, with the exception of the oversample. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
