

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From March 14 to 21, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 111 U.S. transgender adults nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult transgender population by age, gender, race, and education. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ± 9 percentage points. We chose not to release results for subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance and increased margins of error. DATA FOR PROGRESS

From March 14 to 21, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,636 U.S. adults nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult population by age, gender, race, education, region, voter registration, income, and recalled presidential vote. This sample is also weighted to account for an oversample of 111 transgender adults to ensure proportional representation of the adult population. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ± 2 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 0 (<0) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<0 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From March 14 to 21, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,636 U.S. adults nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult population by age, gender, race, education, region, voter registration, income, and recalled presidential vote. This sample is also weighted to account for an oversample of 111 transgender adults to ensure proportional representation of the adult population. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ± 2 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance.
