Georgia (SPECIAL)


Democrat Raphael Warnock leads a crowded field with 30% of the vote, followed by Republican Kelly Loeffler and Republican Doug Collins with 22% each. Democrat Matt Lieberman has 10% of the vote

In testing hypothetical runoff scenarios, Warnock leads Loeffler 44% to 40%, while Lieberman trails Loeffler 41% to 42%

GEORGIA SPECIAL


In the special election for senate in Georgia, Democrat Raphael Warnock leads a crowded field that includes incumbent Republican Senator Kelly Loeffler, Republican Doug Collins, Democrat Matt Lieberman, and Democrat Ed Tarver. Since our last poll, Warnock has improved his position, placing him in a good position to advance to the runoff along with whichever of Loeffler or Collins who comes out ahead.

Warnock Leads a Crowded Field



RUNOFFS

If no candidate wins more than 50% of the vote, the top two candidates will compete in a runoff election. We tested two hypothetical matchups, one in which Democrat Raphael Warnock and Republican Kelly Loeffler advance, and one where Democrat Matt Lieberman and Republican Kelly Loeffler advance. We find that Warnock runs ahead of Lieberman by five points, with Warnock leading 44% to 40% while Lieberman trails 41% to 42%.



METHODOLOGY

From 10/8/2020 to 10/11/2020 Data for Progress conducted a survey of 782 likely voters in Georgia using web panel and SMS respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is +/- 3.5 percentage points.
